Testimonies:

- -Woman received GLOW tract at Taco Bell drive through was convicted and called number on back of literature wanting bible studies.
- -Man finds Sabbath GLOW tract in his bathroom at home reads it, calls in for bible studies and says that he has been keeping the seventh-day Sabbath since childhood but has never heard of Adventists.
- -Young girl places GLOW tract on a table, Merced County Jail Chaplain picks it up, reads it, calls in for literature for all 900 of his men in jail. GLOW sends them 900 Steps to Christ.

G.L.O.W. Church Board Proposal

GLOW (Giving Light to Our World) is a Evangelism Initiative whose aim is to train, inspire, and equip every willing hearted church member to be a literature evangelist by means of free distribution or sales. "Let every believer scatter broadcast tracts and leaflets and books containing the message for this time." R&H, Nov. 12, 1903. The first steps to implement this program in your church are listed below.

- 1. Create a budget for the literature and initial start up materials:
 - a. Initial materials for the kick off weekend are dependent on church attendance and participation on the kick off weekend. The cost for each individual is \$1.50 for literature. This cost includes: 30 GLOW tracts both Spanish and English. Adjustments can be made in regards to the amount of literature desired for each person for the kick-off weekend to help reduce the initial cost if needed.
 - b. For continuance of the GLOW program it takes ~\$83.33 per month plus tax and shipping to maintain the church's ongoing need for literature. This provides for 5,000 pieces per three months.
 - c. All GLOW bills for Central California Conference Churches will show up in the monthly statement issued by the Conference.
- 2. Approve a GLOW Publishing Ministries Coordinator for the church to run the GLOW program.*
